


Spice flagon - with screwed pewter lid

The six sides of the flagon are divided into oval fields by chain decoration. In the fields there are alternating motifs of double eagles, flowers springing from a vase and fruit bowls. The chain motifs extend towards the top, and are surmounted by a vase with a bunch of flowers. The screwed pewter cap is engraved with the inscription *16 M... 16*.
