

Jug - So-called 'Bartmann jug' (Bartmannskrug)

The pear-shaped bowl stands on a round base. Its front is decorated with a sculpted portrait of a bearded man. The middle band shows lines of palmettes and tendrils among them are recurring medallions of a female head.
