

Communion kerchief - from the Calvinist Church of Bagamér

Techniques: two-sided satin stitch

Dimensions: length: 91 cm
width: 91 cm

Decorated with four clusters of flowers stemming from a heart, larger in the corners, smaller on the sides. The ones in the corners are encircled by inscriptions that reads: My Lord, I am in Thy service / unworthy are we.../ István Bencsik Bagaméri / and his wife Anna Szegedi in the year 1660.

A simple embroidery, probably made by the donator.
