

Stove tile

The rectangular shape is framed by broad lines within the frame is an arch, decorated with a lion and cherub heads, joining two columns. The middle of the tile depicts a female figure, holding a bow and looking to her left. Above her is the inscription *DIALECTICA*. Marked *M.B...* Its mould, bearing the date 1668, is in the collection of the Victoria and Albert Museum in London.
