


Cup and saucer

Materials:	hard earthenware
Techniques:	covered with transparent glaze; gilt over glaze
Dimensions:	opening diameter: 7 cm height: 6 cm diameter: 8,5 cm height: 2,5 cm

The cylindrical body of a slightly splayed rim is equipped with a question mark handle. The whole surface is covered with black, transparent glaze, while there is a horizontal, gilt stripe in the middle and below the top rim. The saucer has a rising rim its middle and border are lined with gilt stripes. Both pieces are impressed with maker's mark: "BATIZ".
