Techniques: lead-glazed; polychrome painting

Dimensions: diameter: 36,6 x 26 cm

Oval, with a rising, narrow rim with a horizontal, black border. The surface shows the painted coat of arms of the Count Amade family, with a nine-pointed coronet and a ribbon inscription: „AMORE ET CANDORE”. The arms are enclosed by a rich decoration of scrolling foliage. The dominant colours are red, green, blue and black.
