**Techniques:** applied polychrome glass threads; blown

**Dimensions:**  
height: 38 cm  
base diameter: 8 cm  
opening diameter: 6,5 cm

The broad foot of a splaying rim rises conically in the centre, supporting a spindle-shaped juncture that holds the cylindrical body, which narrows at the bottom and top. The jug ends in a broad, beaked spout. On one side, there is a stirrup handle connecting the body with the top. The whole surface of the jug is decorated with lilac-red, cornflower blue, yellowish, opaque white, black and copper aventurine threads and spots.

The object follows the form of the Greek *oenochoe*, the decoration, on the other hand, is based on the traditions of Venetian-Murano glass.
