


Plate - With the depiction of the Chain Bridge

Materials: **hard earthenware**

Techniques: **thrown in mould; with transfer print**

diameter: 22,5 cm

The large, flat surface has an upwardly curving, wavy rim, decorated with lattice and bunches of flowers. The surface shows the Pest entry of the Chain Bridge, in a rounded, rectangular frame. In the background the Castle of Buda appears. It was probably made after a contemporary copper cut. There is an inscription below *A 'Buda és Pest közötti álló híd' képe* (The picture of the standing bridge between Buda and Pest).
