

Ecet- és olajtartó állvány

Date of production: second half of the 18th cent.

Place of production: Bohemia (presumably);

Materials: faceted glass; pewter

Techniques: cast

Dimensions: height: 21 cm
width: 13,1 cm
length: 22 cm

Stand: the tongue-shaped, curved and jointed plinth stands on four legs. Each of the two bands that hold the cruets are supported by two S-shaped legs they are joined a small, shell-shaped bowl. A stand, composed of two confronting S-shapes emerges from the middle of the bowl, with an oval spicebowl on top. Cruets: cut and faceted glass, with tin setting.
