

# Mortar

## Metalwork Collection

Date of production: first half of the 16th century

Place of production: Italy

Materials: bronze

Techniques: cast

Dimensions: height: 10,5 cm  
opening diameter: 12,5 cm  
length: 22,5 cm

The bell-shaped mortar is divided into four horizontal bands and decorated with acanthus and palmette motifs. On the opposite side to the curving handle there is a relief: a hatchet on an escutcheon. Under the top rim there is an inscription in block capitals: PIERANTONIO.
