


Commemorative kerchief - with the view of the Industrial hall in the Budapest National General Exhibition

The four corners of the antique frame printed in blue with the coat of arms of Hungary, enclosed by laurel wreath and place in a circle. The middle of the sides shows the portrait of Francis-Joseph I (1848-1916) with laurel wreath, enclosed by a leaved fruit wreath twined by ribbons. The centre is decorated with the perspective view of the Industry Hall of the national exhibition, printed in black, surmounted by the *ÉLJEN A HAZA* (Long Live the Nation) and *Budapesti Általános ország/kiállítási emléke 1885* (A souvenir from the comprehensive national exhibition in Budapest, 1885) inscriptions. The copper-printed picture of the Industry Hall was published in *Vasárnapi Újság* (Sunday Magazine), Vol.32/1885, No.14, p.227. Another variant of the kerchief, printed in red, can be found in the collection of the Budapest Museum of Applied Arts (Inv.No. 80.464.1).
