The palmette-shaped leaf is fashioned from a combination of white silk and gold net. In the middle there is a symmetrical composition, a stylized plant motif pouring forth in a fountain-like way. This is flanked on either side by intricate ornamentation consisting of scallop motifs and flowers. Small golden spangles of various shapes and finishes—flat and convex disks, stars, flowers, and almonds—lend magnificence to the ornamentation. The sticks, the edges of which display scalloping, are embellished with love-symbols tied together with ribbon.
