

Fan leaf

Techniques: Chantilly lace

The black leaf, which is edged by open blooms, is divided into three fields by flower festoons and scallop motifs in all of these there is a bouquet of flowers. Attached to the right-hand corner of the leaf, which is embellished with an extremely fine and meticulous pattern, is a label with an inscription: Eventail en / dentelle Chantilly / offert a l'Imperatrice / en 1860 par le ville de / Bayeux, executee aux / fuseaux. = Chantilly lace fan, presented to the Empress by the town of Bayeux in 1860, pillow [lace]. On the other side of the piece of paper are two coats of arms beneath a nine-pointed coronet pressed into red sealing wax with the inscription N° 1. Collection de Doc- / teur Othon Fettick. / Budapest. Other Chantilly lace fans in the collection are MAA inv. nos. 54.82 and 54.2894 (Cat. Nos. 134 and 144).
