

Cabinet - from the Emmer's palace in Buda (Fő Street)

The carved plinth of wavy edges and rococo ornaments is supported by four curved feet. The feet are joint by a stretcher with a cartouche the back ones are also covered by the back panel. The top part has one door, with curved sides and front. The door is carved with a scorch, a horn of plenty, a flute and bunches of ribbons and flowers. The top is surmounted by a crest. Inside, there is a folding plate, with compartments and small drawers.

The furniture belonged to Kornél Emmer's palace in Fő Street, Budapest. The cupboard was manufactured in the furniture factory of the Viennese Friedrich Otto Schmidt, along with some further pieces of the furniture in the Emmer palace.
