

# Vase - With decoration imitating so-called Saracen (Arabic) silk fabric

The oriental decor – included griffins, dragons, qilin and palmette-leaves – adorning the Zsolnay vase, imitates the pattern of a 13th-century North African “Saracen” (Arabic) silk fabric preserved in the Museum of Applied Arts in Vienna.
