

Kétajtós üveges szekrény

The prismatic body stands on four big bun feet with two glass doors of three parts at the front. The top lath of the doors is carved with rods tied with ribbons. The glass panels are enframed by gilt string of pearl motifs. The top of the cupboard is curved and the top frame of the doors follows the curved shape of the top cornice. Below the slightly protruding, concave cornice are string of pearl motifs. Both sides show inlaid lattice of lozenges in two square fields.
