


# Small footed bowl

<b>Techniques:</b>	etched with fluoride acid; polychrome glaze
<b>Dimensions:</b>	diameter: 16 cm height: 6 cm base diameter: 7 cm

The bowl of a short foot shapes a section of a ball. The surface is decorated with ochre, brown, green and blue coulee glaze imitating rays. Outside, the stylised floral ornaments are etched with fluorid acid («ox-blood glaze»).
