

# Pohárka

## Metalwork Collection

**Date of production:** second half of the 19th cent.

**Inscription:** (Id. Rosenberg 1. Nr. 810)

**Materials:** silver-gilt

**Techniques:** repoussé/punched

**Dimensions:** height: 5,7 cm  
base diameter: 3 cm  
opening diameter: 4,9 cm

The domed, round, jointed foot is grooved, supporting a short, stout stem that holds the tapering cup. Its only decoration is at the shoulders, where it is engraved with a lambrequin pattern (imitating curtains) against a punched background. These motifs were fairly wide-spread in the 18th century.
