The ear clips present a stylised vase with flowers the whole surface is covered with white, green, pink flied glass beads of various sizes. This is a historicizing version of an originally Italian jewel type, fairly popular in the 15th-16th centuries, where precious stones were replaced by "surrogate" material.
